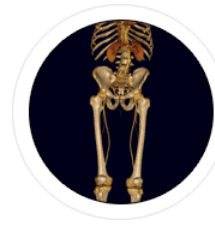

Note that all studies ordered above (except limited sinuses) include Multiplanar and 3-D reconstruction, which we consider vital to interpretation of the study. Please refer to our 3-D policy statement on our website. If you wish to order a study without reconstruction (not recommended) please call to discuss the case.

If patient is allergic to the IV contrast, premedication may be needed **prior** to the test.

If physician is looking at small and or large bowel please order abdomen and pelvis.

If the patient takes anti-inflammatory drugs (nonsteroidal) over the counter or prescription such as Motrin, Ibuprofen, Tylenol, Aleve, these need to be stopped the day before the exam and 2 days after. Aspirin can be taken.

Any patient that is diabetic, high blood pressure, or kidney problems and/or is over 65 years old will need a blood test to check the creatinine level prior to getting the IV contrast.

If patient has Sickle Cell Disease or Multiple Myeloma please let AACT know **prior** to the scan.

**PATIENT INSTRUCTIONS**

- Patients for abdomen and or pelvis must drink 1.5 quarts of water or other noncarbonated decaffeinated drinks (Gatorade or lemonade) 1 hour prior to scan.
- Patient may void.

Patients receiving IV contrast should not eat anything except medication 3hrs. before scan. Diabetic patients receiving IV contrast that take any of these drugs, **Advandamet, Fortamet, Glucophage, Glucovance, Januvia, Metaglip, Metformin, Actoplus Met, or Janumet** must stop taking the medication the day of the scan and 2 days after.
